Threshold verdict returned January 7th before Judge Eckerle – Marc Breit defending

In one of the first civil jury trials of 2015, Marc Breit defended a car wreck case in Louisville before Judge Eckerle. The jury claimed a shoulder injury (repaired by Dr. Kuiper) from a disputed liability crash. A threshold verdict was returned. Breit is the undisputed King of the Threshold. No one else comes close. Since 1999 in 23 car wreck trials Breit has presented a threshold defense. A threshold verdict has been returned in **22** of those cases. That is a 95.6% success rate. That indicates Breit does two things pretty well, (1) he tries a good case, and (2) he correctly evaluates the cases he can win and tries those, settling the ones that he can't.
