Marc Breit is back on a roll. Tried 53 civil cases from 1998 to 2014 -- second most in Kentucky. But none in 2014.

Has tried two so far THIS month. One a threshold verdict in Louisville.

Most recently last week he took a medicals/no suffering verdict in Shelby County in the case of Ference v. Poulter.

Plaintiff claimed a post-concussive brain injury after a significant impact. Live psychiatrist. Live vocational expert.

\$1.7 million demand in damages including \$1,000,000 for suffering. Fault no issue.

Jury awarded medicals of \$1,684 and lost wages of \$1,326. No pain. No suffering. Verdict totaled \$3,010.
